Triad™ Hydrophilic Wound Dressing

Indications:

For the local management of pressure and venous stasis ulcers, dermal lesions/injuries, superficial wounds, scrapes, first- and second-degree burns, partial- and full-thickness wounds.

Contradictions:

Third-degree burns or infected wounds

Ingredients:

Petrolatum, Zinc Oxide, Hydrophilic Powder (Sterculia Urens Gum) and Mineral Oil

Directions:

1. Cleanse wound thoroughly using **Sea-Cleans®** Wound Cleanser or normal saline.
2. Apply **Triad™** Hydrophilic Wound Dressing directly into the wound, filling the wound bed and apply a lighter layer on the surrounding periwound area.
3. Cover with a secondary wound dressing as necessary.
4. When **Triad** Hydrophilic Wound Dressing liquifies, strikes through secondary dressings or leaks change dressing.
5. Change dressing at least every 5-7 days or as necessary, and repeat procedure.

Periwound skin care: Total skin care of a wound includes the periwound area.
